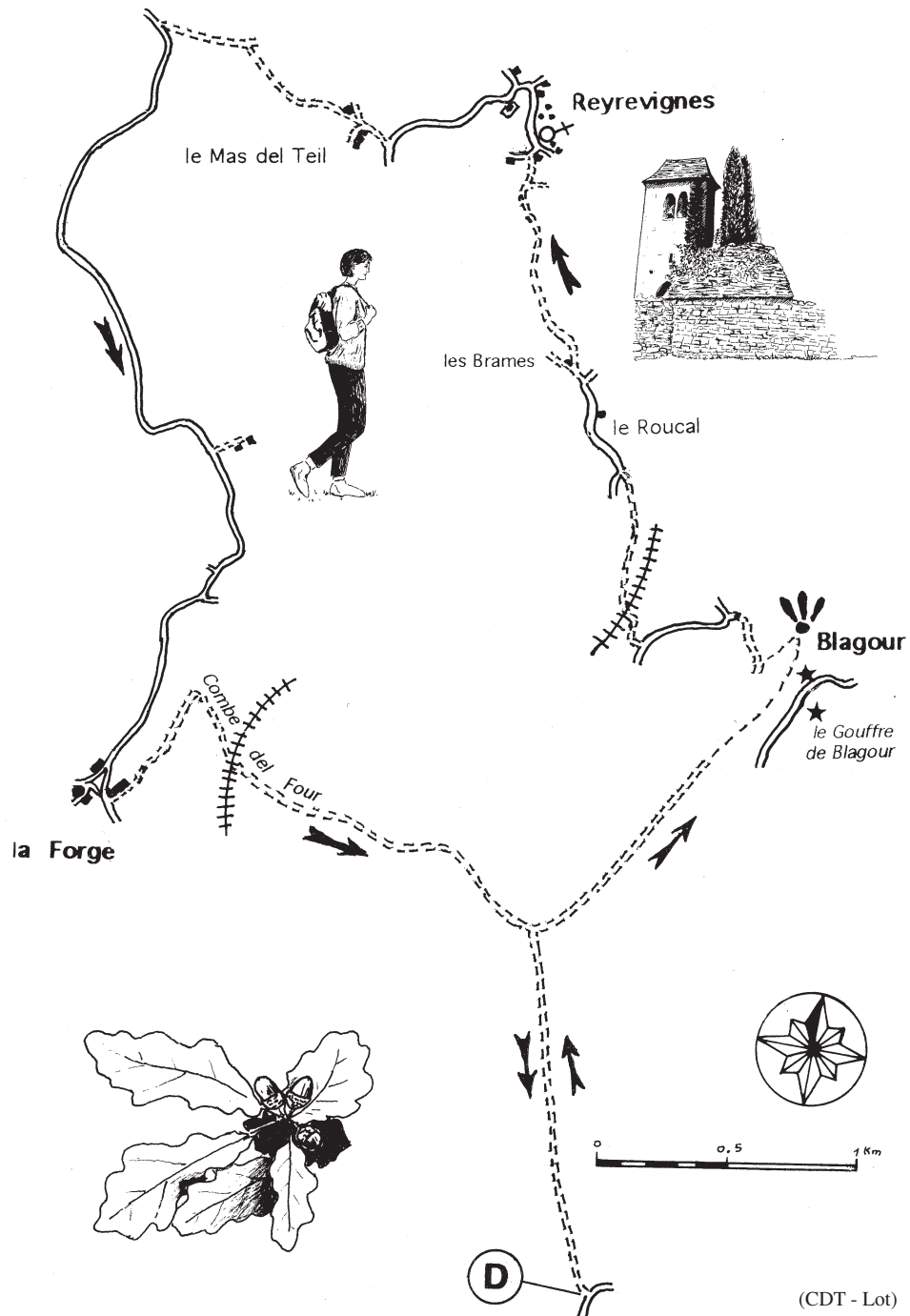

Reyrevignes round walk

This walk will show you the coombs and plateaux of the north of the Lot going via the pretty hamlet of Reyrevignes. The railway viaducts built in the late 19th century for the Paris-Toulouse line add a strange yet harmonious note to the landscape.

REYREVIGNES ROUND WALK



Distance : 17 km. Time : 5 hrs.

Starting point : Blagour municipal stadium

Waymarking : yellow. Accessible : on foot only

From the stadium, go towards the Blagour fish farm. Take a path on the left going up to the plateau. When you come to a cross track, turn right and go straight on for 1 km: enjoy the viewpoint then turn left and come out on a road: turn left. As you come round a bend, take a track to the right going over the railway line then down to a road (50 m to the left, you can go and see the Boulet spring). Turn right, go past the houses of Le Roucal, and on a right-hand bend in the road, go straight on towards Les Brames.

By an electricity pole, take a little track to the right going behind the houses. Further on, at a fork, take a track off to the left bordered by a stone wall, leading to the hamlet of Reyrevignes. Opposite the church, carry on to the left then go towards Lamothe-Timbergues. At the Mas del Teil, take the first track on the right; 100 m further on, turn right then left on a cross-track. At a fork, take the right-hand track which goes down into a coomb then turns left and comes to a road. Follow this 2 km to a crossroads: turn right and come out further along on another road which crosses it. Turn left then left again between some farm buildings.

Follow the main track which goes under the railway then up a coomb. At the top of this, the track turns right: leave it 20 m further on, taking a path on the left which brings you to another track. Follow this to the left to a cross track. Cross over and go under an electricity line; come to a track that takes you up to a junction. Turn right then left to get back on the Blagour road and to your starting point.

To see :

- Blagour Mill and Chasm;
- the Boulet spring; the Mas del Teil;
- the Forge.
